NOTICE to TOWN of CHESWOLD RESIDENTS 2015 MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

Four, (4), Town Council terms of office will expire on Friday, March 27, 2015. A **Municipal Election** will be held on **Tuesday, March 24, 2015**, at the **Cheswold Fire Hall**, to staff these positions. The Polling Place will be open from **2:00 p.m., until 7:00 p.m.**

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS:

Residents wishing to run for office in the 2015 Cheswold Municipal Election must meet the following qualifications:

1. Candidates shall file a NOTICE of INTENTION form to seek office. The form is available at the Town Hall.
2. Form must be submitted by Friday, February 13, 2015 at 4:30 p.m.
3. Candidates must be at least 21 years old.
4. Candidates must be a resident of Cheswold for at least one year prior to the date of the election.
5. Candidates must be registered and qualified to vote in the election.
6. No person convicted of a felony or a crime of moral turpitude shall be qualified to be a candidate for office on the Town Council.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS:

Any person shall be qualified to vote who:

1. On the date of the election is a citizen of the United States of America.
2. Is at least 18 years of age.
3. Is registered in the Town of Cheswold to vote.
4. Has been a resident of Cheswold for at least 90 days prior to the date of the Election.

VOTER REGISTRATION:

- Residents may register to vote at the Cheswold Town Hall, Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 4:00 pm
- Last day for registering to vote is Wednesday, March 18, 2015 at 4:00 pm.
- Normal voter registration for future elections will resume on April 1, 2015.
- Residents registering to vote for the first time must show proof of identification, such as a driver's license and proof of 90 day residency in Town. A utility bill may be used for this purpose.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS:

- Absentee ballots can be obtained at the Town Hall beginning Friday, March 13, 2015 until 12:00 pm, through Monday, March 23, 2015, at 4:30 pm.
- Absentee ballots if returned by mail must reach Town Hall by close of business Monday, March 23; if returned by hand it may be delivered to the Cheswold Fire Hall by 7:00 pm, March 24, 2015.
- Copies of the Absentee Ballot Voting Procedures are available at Town Hall
- Absentee ballots returned in the mail must be returned in the provided self-addressed envelopes.
