

Milford School District Board of Education Referendum Election

AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,938,300 FOR MAJOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS. THE BONDS ARE TO BE FINANCED THROUGH AN INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES. THE BONDS REPRESENT 29% OF THE TOTAL COST OF \$44,614,900 FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECT:
